3. Description of the training offered:

This training is meant to prepare individuals to become automotive technicians. The program is full-time, from 7:00 am - 3:30 pm five days a week. The training blends classroom training with hands-on experiences in a real automotive shop.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

Trainees have the opportunity to earn a variety of student level Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) certifications.

5. Am I eligible?

To be eligible for this training program, applicants must:

- Be 18+ or older
- Have a High School Diploma or GED® (not required, but preferred)
- Previous mechanical inclination is preferred, automotive/c-tech experience is a plus

Note: this program primarily trains returning citizens. Completing the automotive technician class while incarcerated is a plus.

7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment in the automotive field?

Trainees who complete this program and obtain employment can expect to earn an average of \$17 to \$21 per hour, at an entry level position.
