#### 3. Description of the training offered:

ADEI is an automotive apprenticeship program that helps individuals interested in pursuing a career as an automotive technician find a job at a local new car dealership and then attend certified classroom training on one of their days off. After two years, our apprentices have the experience and training required to become certified master technicians, all at no cost to them.

#### 5. Am I eligible?

Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Must be 18 years or older
- Have a Valid Driver's License
- Must be able to pass a background check and not have any auto or violent related felonies

#### 6. What is the application process?

Our apprentices make \$16-17 per hour to start and \$23-24 per hour at the program's completion. Seasoned technicians can then have the ability to make \$100k or more per year.
