## POSITION DUTIES:

- Under close supervision, trains to operate and operates a variety of radios, telephones, keyboards, computers and other electronic devices in the County 911 Center in order to receive and respond to requests for emergency assistance, and to dispatch Fire/EMS or Police units to alleviate situations that endanger or potentially endanger, lives and/or property in Baltimore County.

## QUALIFICATIONS:

- Possession of a high school diploma or an appropriate equivalent.
- Applicants must be at least 18 years of age at the time of appointment.
- All applicants must be of good moral character and emotionally stable, as determined by a comprehensive background investigation and drug test.
- Upon completion of the training program, the following certifications are required: Possession of valid Emergency Medical Dispatcher certificate issued by the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems and valid Emergency Fire, Medical, and Police Dispatcher certificates issued by the International Academies of Emergency Dispatch (IAED).
