#### **3. Description of the training offered:**

This training is meant to prepare individuals for entry-level careers in cybersecurity. Currently, classes are being offered online and include classroom instruction and hands-on training.

Day Time and Evening Classes based on enrollment (Each training is 12 weeks, Total of 48 weeks)

- The A+ course covers fundamental computer and career skills for entry-level IT positions.
- The Network+ course includes hands-on labs that provide experience to prepare students for enterprise network.
- The Security+ course provides students the skills to plan, implement, and maintain information security. This includes risk management, host and network security, authentication and access control systems, cryptography and organizational security.
- The CCENT course covers the concepts and skills to install, operate and troubleshoot a small enterprise branch network, including basic network security. The CCNA Security course will provide you the associate level knowledge and skills required to secure networks, develop a security infrastructure, recognize threats and vulnerabilities to networks, and mitigate security threats.
