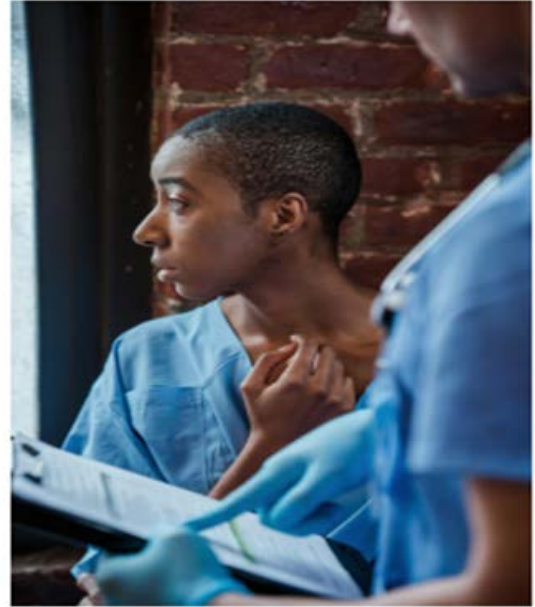
- Complete a TABE or CASAS placement test.
